Special presentation of an engraved pen set to \*Capt Paula Marshall for her contributions to the Quantico Chapter. Capt Marshall will PCS in early December to Monterey, California where she will begin her FAO program.

### **V. NEW BUSINESS**

- a. Scholarship/ Mentorship Opportunity – report by **Capt Ayres** and **Major Everly** on behalf of Major Loney. Capt Ayres reported that they are in the process of getting the corporate letters sent out and that the committee is trying to get more participating schools for the Dollars for Scholars Program. Major Everly reported that the intent is for the Scholarship Banquet to be in the month of March and focused on fundraising. The weekend of 16-17 March has been tentatively proposed with a Golf Tournament on that Friday (16 March) followed by the Scholarship Banquet on Saturday (17 March). He also introduced a mentorship opportunity for the chapter. Mary Washington University has a program focused on underprivileged 7<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> grade students for whom mentors are needed. The commitment to these students would be one Saturday/month. Major Loney is set to do a test run in December. Chapter start date- January 07.
- b. Membership Initiative- **Capt Armour** provided a handout of the Quantico Chapter's Membership Plan (1 July 2006- 30 June 2007) as well as an overview of the membership fees as posted on the NNOA website in particular the 2 and 3 year renewal options. Also discussed assigning a point system to chapter events/functions most attended by chapter members/nonmembers as a future membership incentive program. More informal gatherings as a chapter were proposed such as 2 on 2 Basketball, Family Skate Day, Ski Trip and Bring your Boss Wing Night. In closing, Capt Armour encouraged all members to verify their chapter affiliation on the national website as Quantico.
- c. Veteran's Home Visit- **Capt Ayres** reported that the Veteran's Home Visit will take place on 29 November from 1400-1500 @ Walter Reed Medical Center. Because the visit is limited to 5 people, sign up will be on a first come, first serve basis. Other options for future Veteran home visits include a medical nursing home in Richmond and the Soldier's home in Washington, DC. The President's vision is that these home visits become a regular routine for the chapter.
